Wood Badge will be held in the spring and fall:

Spring course is Jun 4-6 (Fri-Sun) and Jul 10-11 (Sat-Sun)

Fall course is Aug 27-29 (Fri-Sun) and Sep 11-12 (Sat – Sun)

Both courses will be held at Camp Emerson at the Boseker Scout Reservation in Idyllwild.

An orientation will be held prior to the course, dates to be determined.
